## Program Basics - Repositioning Images in the Picture Windows

The following Mouse Functions can be used both in the Main PictureWindow and the Jaw- and Occlusogram Window.

1. To translate the whole screen image:

Position the cursor in the window.
Press <Ctrl> and <LeftMouse> and drag while holding <LeftMouse> down.

3. To zoom in on part of an image:

Hold <RightMouse> and drag a rectangle

2. To rotate the whole screen image: Position the cursor in the window. Press <Alt> and <LeftMouse> and drag while holding <LeftMouse> down.


Release <RightMouse>

4. To reset the an image to its original size:

Press <RightMouse>
Pressing <RightMouse> repeatedly will toggle between 1:1 size and $75 \%$ size

The following icons can only be used in the Main PictureWindow:


Zoom In Pressing the icon or hitting <F10> enlarges the picture in 10\% steps
Zoom Out Pressing the icon or hitting <F11> reduces the picture size in $10 \%$ steps

Center Pressing the icon or hitting <F12> will center the picture in the window
